1. What is good about the draft. Please be specific and why it is a good thing or section in your opinion.

3. Where is the thesis? Write it here.
4. What is the attention device? Write it here and say whether or not it is effective.

5. How does the paper end? Does it do everything a conclusion should do? Why or why not?
